- 45.8% of grades awarded were A\*-A, the highest since in an examination year since the A level reform of 2016
- 77.5% of grades were at A\*-B, the highest since A level reform of 2016
- 18% of grades awarded were A, the highest since 2018
- 1/3 of students received at least 1 A\*
- Almost 20% of students received 2A\*'s or more
