WHAT CAN YOUR FUNDRAISING PAY FOR

- £5 = train young researchers to collect surveys on the impacts of climate change in their local communities
- £25 = provide a day of business training and give a young person life-changing skills.
- £50 = support a young volunteer to mentor hundreds of young girls every month with skills in literacy, numeracy and business.
- £98 = train ten young people to become climate champions, by learning about climate change and how to urge their communities to take action
