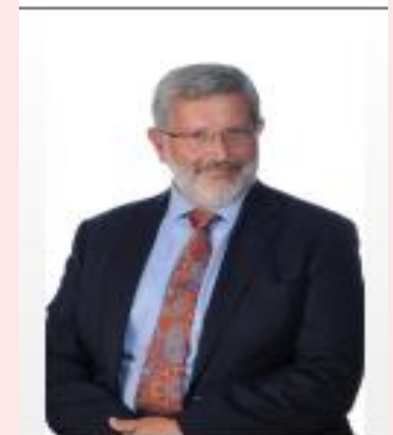

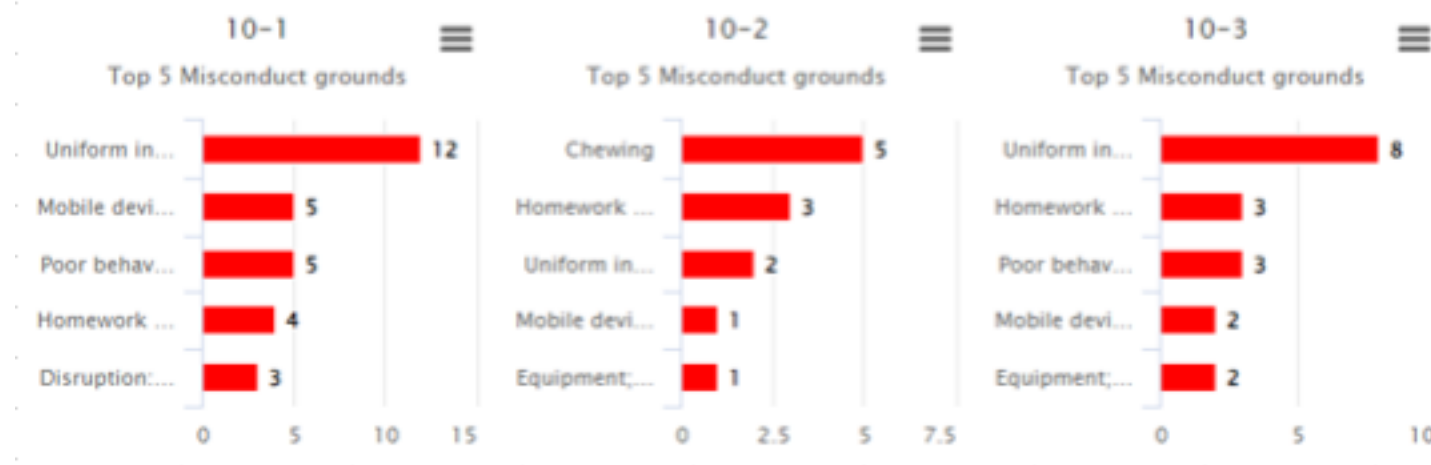

Bristol Education partnership Leadership course

Two positions available to Year 10

- A pupil who completes the programme will:
 - Understand what leadership is, be aware of the leadership skills they possess and know how to develop these and other relevant skills
 - Appreciate the impact that their actions and beliefs have on others and on their school, and know how to work to bring about improved outcomes
 - Set appropriate goals for themselves and support others in achieving their goals
 - Be able to give and receive feedback appropriately
 - Take responsibility for their own actions



BRISTOL EDUCATION PARTNERSHIP LEADERSHIP COURSE

The training consists of six sessions (some face-to-face and some online).

Pupils also need to complete a reflective journal which documents their experiences throughout the training.

An “Apprentice” style social-action task is carried out in small groups over the course of the programme and the feedback session forms part of the final assessment

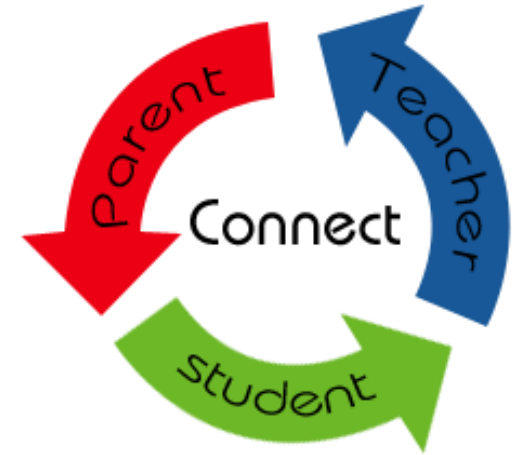
- Why you want to take part in the Leadership programme
