Head of Year detention (time to reflect) on reaching 5 Misconduct Marks in any half term period or for one off events


Academic detention (academic catch-up session) if work is poor and homework not completed

GCSE OPTIONS 2025

Discussions surrounding this will start now with Tutors. We ask the pupils to start drafting their plans to get an idea of the curriculum they are thinking of. Health and Wellbeing lessons as well as 1-1 time will provide time for this to take place.

Following the **Year 9 Options Evening** on **Monday 18th November 2024** and the issue of the GCSE options booklet (2024 version can be viewed online via the website) there will be further time for pupils to discuss their plans with Tutors, Subject teachers, and parents.

The Year 9 Parents' Evening on Tuesday 21st January 2025 will give pupils and their parents an opportunity to discuss choices with staff, clarify any uncertainties and consider the advisability of choosing specific subjects.

Pupils will then have until **Tuesday 28th January 2025** to finalise their decisions and submit their options via the parent portal.

After this date it is possible for pupils to change their mind about their choices - if these then fit in with the option blocks that will have since been created.


